





Designed by esteemed yacht architect, Marcelo Penna, of Barcelona and constructed by Indonesia's traditional boat builders, Lamima seamlessly combines the authenticity of a two masted phinisi with the latest yacht design and technology

AN OVERVIEW OF LAMIMA

- At 65 metres long Lamima is one of the world's largest 5 star wooden sailing yachts, offering a greater range and capacity than any other vessels in the region
- Crew of 20 including dive instructors, chefs and spa therapists.
- Spacious saloon furnished with a bar, lounge and a huge dining table plus expansive external deck space for al fresco dining and relaxing.
- Up to 14 guests in seven elegant and spacious staterooms including a two twin cabins, all with ensuite

Raja Ampat

WEST PAPUA, INDONESIA

Remote and undisturbed, the breathtakingly beautiful islands of Raja Ampat are a nature lovers' paradise.

Bursting with colour thanks to the incredibly healthy coral, the warm waters are home to reef sharks, manta rays, and whale sharks and offer some of the best diving and snorkelling opportunities in the world.

On land, many stunning species of Birds of Paradise inhabit the islands and can be seen on island treks or while paddle-boarding close to the shore.

Locations such as Wayag are famous for their panoramic views and bays filled with small islands, while local villages offer cultural excursions and some of the warmest hospitality you will ever encounter.













Komodo & Flores

EAST NUSA TENGGARA, INDONESIA

Lying just to the west of Flores in
Eastern Indonesia, the grassy sloped
islands of Komodo National Park offer
visitors gentle trekking trails and
beautiful beaches to relax on.

Dolphins are frequently spotted in the area, which also lies along a whale migration route. Rich in marine life, the park's vibrant coral reefs are regarded as some of the finest, offering world-class diving opportunities.

The National Park is also home to the famous Komodo Dragons, the largest living lizards on Earth, and they are found only on Komodo and Rinca islands.

Heading eastwards, 17 Islands National Park boasts huge colonies of flying foxes, colourful coral gardens, and crystal-clear water, while Mt. Kelimutu's spectacularly coloured volcanic lakes and Alor's tribal communities are real highlights.






