













DESTINATIONS KOMODO NATIONAL PARK

Komodo National Park lies in the Wallacea Region of Indonesia, identified by WWF and Conservation International as a global conservation priority area. It was declared a World Heritage Site by UNESCO and is located in the centre of the Indonesian archipelago, between the islands of Sumbawa and Flores.

Komodo National Park includes three major islands: Komodo, Rinca, and Padar, as well as numerous smaller islands, creating a total surface area (marine and land) of more than 1,800 km². As well as being home to the Komodo Dragon—the world's largest living lizard that can reach 3 metres in length and weigh over 70 kg—the park provides refuge for many other notable terrestrial species.

As far as the marine fauna is concerned, Komodo National Park is one of the world's richest marine environments. It consists of over 260 species of reef-building coral, 70 different species of sponges, crustaceans, cartilaginous species (including manta rays and sharks), and over 1,000 different species of bony fishes, as well as marine reptiles (including sea turtles) and marine mammals (dolphins, whales, and dugongs).







DESTINATIONS ALOR ARCHIPELAGO

Located to the east of Flores, the Alor archipelago is formed by 20 pristine islands and is becoming famous for its world-class diving, scenic underwater rock formations, abundant fish life, virgin coral walls, and slopes. The main attractions are the seasonal passage of whales and diving with such unique underwater creatures as Mola Mola (Sunfish), thresher sharks, whales, giant groupers, and more.

Cruising the archipelago is pure bliss; most of this huge chain of islands enjoys calm seas and warm sunny weather throughout most of the year. The cruise to Alor will not be complete without venturing deep into the countryside and visiting some of the friendliest and most authentic tribes and traditional villages in Indonesia. Time seems to have stopped here centuries ago, providing a unique experience in our busy world.








DESTINATIONS WAKATOBI MARINE PARK

The third largest marine park in Indonesia. Legendary underwater explorer and conservationist, Jacques Cousteau is said to have called the Wakatobi islands—then known as the Tukangbesi islands—an "Underwater Nirwana".

Now a National Marine Park covering the entire Wakatobi District, it comprises a total of 1.4 million hectares, of which 900,000 hectares are decorated with colourful species of tropical coral reefs.

Rising from the depths of the Banda Sea, south-east of the mainland of Sulawesi, the main islands of Wangi, Kaledupa, Tomea, Binongki—Wakatobi reefs are different from others in the region due to dry climate and uplifted limestone. The environment is exceptionally clean due to the lack of soil erosion. Wakatobi is widely recognised as having the highest number of reef and fish species in the world. The islands are also famous as the largest barrier reef in Indonesia, second only to the Great Barrier Reef in Australia. This is the habitat of large and small fish species, the playground of dolphins, turtles, and even whales.

MAIN FEATURE

The 31 metre-long Alexa consists of two decks and has been built by hand in the traditional style of a Phinisi. In keeping with Oazia's emphasis on style and sustainability, the furniture throughout the boat is custom-made from teak, rattan and other locally sourced materials from Indonesia.

ACCOMMODATION

One well-appointed suite, with air-conditioning and a king-size bed, ensuite bathroom with shower, double wardrobe, and balcony relaxation area. The master suite boasts large, wraparound windows offering 270-degree views of the ever-changing incredible landscape, providing the ultimate space for relaxation.



FACILITIES

A library, lounge, open kitchen, indoor dining area seating up to 4 people, Under the Stars sleeping area, and plenty of space outside to unwind and enjoy the views. Guests will be able to dine at leisure in the air-conditioned dining room or on the outdoor deck. Meals and an extensive list of nonalcoholic beverages are all inclusive, while alcoholic beverages including wines, beers, and cocktails are available for an additional charge. The main outdoor deck has large oversized daybeds shaded by tarpaulin—perfect for relaxing day or night and enjoying the fresh sea breezes. And with a spa therapist aboard the vessel, guests can succumb to the soothing pleasures of a signature Alexa massage on board or on a nearby beach.









ACTIVITIES

Alexa also has its own fully licensed PADI dive centre, catering to qualified divers.

Development courses offered on board range from Open Water Diver to over 16 specialties, including Deep, Peak Performance Buoyancy, Drift and Underwater Naturalist. There is plenty of equipment for all guests on board as well as a dedicated freshwater rinse tank for camera equipment. For those with a taste for adventure, surfing, fishing, snorkelling, visiting local islands and pearl farms are among the many other pursuits on offer.

Ultimately, Alexa was built for two; however, we can offer the following combination: 2 adults + 2 adults, or 2 adults + up to 2 children. A surcharge per night applies. Alcohol is available on board for an additional cost, or we can offer an all-inclusive option at a supplement.
