


Mutiara Laut's lounge area serves dual purposes, transforming from a serene spot for morning yoga to a tranquil lounge enveloped by the natural breeze.












































Raja Ampat, translated to the "Four Kings", is located off the tip of Bird's Head Peninsula in remote New Guinea, Indonesia's West Papua province.


Best known for its diverse underwater landscapes on the planet, the Raja Ampat archipelago consists of four main islands: Misool, Salawati, Batanta, and Waigeo, surrounded by 1,500 smaller islands.

Situated in the centre of the Coral Triangle, Raja Ampat is a prized crown jewel of Indonesia's famed waters and a global centre of marine biodiversity. An epicentre for underwater adventure, the

Raja Ampat archipelago is one of Indonesia's largest protected marine areas and is the world's richest coral reef ecosystem. Its vibrant waters are home to over 75% of the world's hard coral species, with new species discovered regularly.









Located at the eastern side of the Lesser Sunda Islands, Alor and its neighbouring islands of Solor, Pantar, and Lembata offer a wild volcanic landscape with a rich, colourful culture. The Sunda's Islands' abundant and flourishing marine life is attributed to the strong currents flowing through the narrow straits. These currents provide exhilarating drift dives over the pristine coral ecosystem and breathtaking encounters with pelagics, including hammerhead and thresher sharks.

Stunning landscapes await as you travel overland to the lost villages of the Abui tribe, who to this day stay true to their traditional way of life and are also known for their colourful hand-crafted textiles created with techniques passed down through generations.


A cruise through the Alor archipelago is ideal for those who desire an idyllic blend of exhilarating marine adventure and witnessing cultures yet to be altered by toursim.







The Forgotten Islands and The Bandas are a chain of small volcanic islands situated between Timor and West Papua. Often referred to as the Southwest Moluccas, these rarely accessible islands offer a rich checkered history that paved the way to our present world. Located in a remote area where diverging currents bringing nutrient- dense water meet, the Forgotten Islands is adiver's Paradise! Nils Desperendum and Terbang are two significant diving hotspots and are best known for the large schools of sharks hammerhead that live travel throughout the waters of the Banda Sea. A truly exhilarating and unforgettable dive! These waters are a kaleidoscope of color and underwater landscapes, offering deepwalls, flourishing colorful corals, pinnacles, and volcanic slopes.




















Birdwatching in Indonesia's untouched, biodiverse landscapes offers a rich experience, as these rainforests are home to numerous unique endemic species found only in this part of the world. One such species is the flamboyant Birds of Paradise found in the eastern island of Papua. Best known for its unique ,dance mating rituals, the Birds of Paradise put on a spectacular display in an attempt to attract the perfect mate. Other endemic species found on Papua are flightless Southern Cassowary known for its bright blue neck, hornbill, and deadly claws, and smaller species such as the Victoria Crowned Pigeon or a variety of brightly colored Kingfishers.







Blissful relaxation with breathtaking views and ocean breezes is guaranteed on every Mutiara Laut.
