



Pirates of the Golden Age

John Rackham (26 December 1682 – 18 November 1720), [commonly known as Calico Jack, was an English pirate captain operating in the Bahamas and in Cuba during the early 18th century.

His nickname was derived from the calico clothing that he wore, while Jack is a generic nickname for a British Sailor.

Rackham was active towards the end (1718–1720) of the "Golden Age of Piracy". He is most remembered for having two female crew members: Mary Read and his lover, Anne Bonny.



The beginning

Calico Jack was built in Sulawesi in 2011-2013, by a group of friends from the UK, Australia and France. Anne Bonny was also built in Sulawesi, in 2015, by an accomplished Italian boat builder. Calico Jack Charters purchased Mantra in June 2022, extensively renovated and rebranded her as Anne Bonny.





Front of the boat


Large open space with comfy sofa.

- Breakfasts are semi-buffet, lunches are buffet-style and dinners are served ala-carte.






Areas of Operation

Raja Ampat


We run 2 types of open cruises in Raja Ampat:

We are open for charter bookings in Raja Ampat with a minimum duration of 5 nights.






Banda Neira

The cruise departs from Ambon and finishes in Sorong.






Lost LeBlanc
